Dear Chairman Aderholt and Ranking Member Farr,

We respectfully ask that you allocate \$236,120 million for the Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP) in the Fiscal Year 2017 Agriculture Appropriations bill. This funding level is consistent with the President's fiscal year 2017 budget request. We support the budget request for an additional 20,000 slots, recognizing that states have asked for even more than this amount.


As you know, CSFP is a critical nutrition program that delivers U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) commodities primarily to seniors. In this time of continued economic hardship, reliance on nutrition assistance is greater than ever. CSFP is an important component of our nutrition efforts because it reaches many seniors who qualify for no other program while providing delivery for those that are homebound.

CSFP provides 619,000 food packages each month in 47 states, the District of Columbia, and 2 Indian Tribal Organizations. This year 99 percent of the participants are elderly individuals with an income at or below \$15,301. CSFP food packages are designed to supplement needed sources of nutrients typically lacking in participants' diets, including protein, iron, zinc, and vitamins B-6 and B-12. CSFP providers also have been very cost efficient: the typical food package has a retail value up to \$50 but costs the Federal government approximately \$23 per participant package.



We appreciate your consideration of this important request and look forward to continuing to work with you to ensure that no American goes hungry.


