Dear Chair Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Public Works and Emergency Operations Floodplain Relocation Project in fiscal year 2027.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Del Mar, located at 1050 Camino Del Mar, Del Mar, CA 92014. The funding would be used to relocate critical public works facilities, storage areas, and equipment currently located within the floodplain to higher, safer ground and construct elevated equipment storage yards, storm-resilient public works infrastructure, and site grading and elevation improvements.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it would improve emergency preparedness, continuity of essential public works operations, community safety, and economic development for the residents, businesses, and visitors that depend on efficient and reliable public works services.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C.5305(a)(1), 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and/or 5305(a)(5).
