Dear Chair Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Del Mar Bluffs Stabilization Phase 5 Continuation Project in fiscal year 2027.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the San Diego Association of Governments, located at 1011 Union Street, Suite 400, San Diego, CA 92101. The funding would be used to reinforce the eroding bluffs in Del Mar that support the LOSSAN Rail Corridor by installing additional support columns, retaining walls, drainage improvements, and erosion control measures between rail milepost (MP) 244.1 and MP 245.7.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it would protect this critical transportation corridor from bluff erosion to support safe and reliable rail service for passengers, freight, and military logistics.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by section 22907 of title 49 of the United States Code.
