Dear Chair Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the El Camino Real and Spring Street Pedestrian Safety & Accessibility Improvements Project in fiscal year 2027.

The entity to receive funding for this project is City of San Juan Capistrano, located at 23400 Paseo Adelanto, San Juan Capistrano, CA 92675. The funding would be used to install new ADA-compliant concrete sidewalks and on-street parking along El Camino Real and Spring Street adjacent to Capistrano Unified School District schools, San Juan Elementary School, and Mission Basilica School.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it would improve pedestrian safety and accessibility, encourage active modes of school transportation, and promote economic growth by increasing foot traffic and addressing parking needs.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C.5305(a)(1), 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and/or 5305(a)(5).
